### Equine Eye Anatomy and Physiology - The Horse

The thickness of the equine cornea is 1.0–1.5 mm in the center and 0.8 mm at the periphery. The normal equine corneal epithelium is 8–10 cell layers thick and increases after corneal injury. The stroma is primarily collagen. Descemet's membrane is the 21- m-thick basement membrane of the inner endothelial cell layer.<sup>10,11</sup>
