If indeed the intimate association right, wherever found, is a fundamental one, I would think the narrowly tailored means to meet a compelling state interest standard would be involved and a mere government interest in efficiency would hardly be enough to permit the demotion in these circumstances. Next, the Supreme Court articulated a more subtle right to “intimate association,” declaring that citizens have the right to “enter into and maintain certain intimate human relationships [that] must be secured against undue intrusion by the State because of the role such relationships [have] in safeguarding the individual freedom that is central to our constitutional scheme.”

In sum, the United States Constitution protects close and intimate associations among family members. The government cannot arbitrarily and intentionally interfere with protected familial relationships nor can the government retaliate against one family member for another family member’s engaging in protected First Amendment activity. But, the bar has been raised for intimate association claims under the Fourteenth Amendment.

Dale*, 633 the Court held that application of New Jersey’s public accommodations law to require the Boy Scouts of America to admit an avowed homosexual as an adult member violated the organization’s “ First Amendment right of expressive association.” 634 Citing *Hurley*,...

Intimate association - small, personal gatherings - are protected. Additionally, if discrimination is in fact the very message or expressive purpose behind the association, it is protected. The message exception was affirmed in the decision *Boy Scouts of America v. Dale* in 2000.
